### *Energy Efficient Buildings: A Plan for BC*

#### **Building Sector — Residential**

New single family and row house residential buildings

#### **Energy Efficiency Target**

Achieve an EnerGuide for New Houses rating of 80 by 2010, reducing average energy consumption in new homes by 32%

New Multi-unit residential buildings

Achieve energy performance of 25% better than Model National Energy Code for Buildings by 2010, reducing average energy consumption by 37%

Existing single family and row house residential buildings

Reduce the energy consumption in 12% of existing buildings by an average of 17% by 2010

Existing multi-unit residential buildings

Reduce the energy consumption in 16% of existing buildings by an average of 9% by 2010

#### **Building Sector — Other**

New industrial, commercial and institutional buildings

#### **Energy Efficiency Target**

Achieve energy performance of 25% better than Model National Energy Code for Buildings by 2010, reducing average energy consumption by 20%

Existing industrial, commercial and institutional buildings

Reduce the energy consumption in 20% of existing buildings by an average of 14% by 2010
