We're happy to share some exciting news about program updates impacting eligible heat pump rebates in the Home Renovation and Provincial Rebate program.

Invoices dated on or after April 1 will be eligible for the following heat pump rebates:

How to apply

Customers apply for their rebates online at EfficiencyBC.ca/incentives and are required to provide the following supporting documentation:

- Invoices must show the make, model, HSPF, SEER, number of tons, variable speed compressor and AHRI reference number.
 - Attached is a copy of the sample invoice for heat pumps that outlines the required information.
 - If switching from fossil fuel, proof of removal or decommissioning is also required.

Key Terms & Conditions

The following requirements remain the same:

- Must be installed by licensed contractor with a valid BC business license
- Maximum one heat pump system rebate per Premises
